RANGE Rules

Range Rules	Date Adopted
<p>Any club member or guest failing to adhere to these rules may be denied range privileges and is subject to disciplinary action.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eye and ear protection is required on the range at all times. • Always sign in, note your firing position, and report all damage caused or found by you in the sign in book and to a club officer. • When the “cease fire” order is given, all shooting must stop immediately and firearms must be unloaded and “benched” immediately. • Use All of the ventilation fans when shooting any firearm. • No handling or un-casing of firearms when people are downrange. • Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot. • Maintain muzzle control at all times. • A “benched” firearm must be unloaded with the action open, magazine out, cylinder open and chamber(s) empty, Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) installed, and muzzle pointed downrange. • No moving about the club house or range with loaded firearms or closed actions. • The only allowable center fire ammunition consists of any standard handgun caliber fired in a hand gun or rifle with a maximum velocity of 1500 feet per second. All .22 caliber or smaller rim fire ammunition is allowed and not subject to the above velocity restriction. • Black powder, shot shells, steel core , incendiary rounds, or paint balls are prohibited. • Use only Club approved targets, properly mounted so that your bullet strikes the backstop without deflection. • Combat style shooting: Targets must be hung at the backstop, firing will only be from the 25 yard line and only use bench positions 3 and 8. • No shooting closer than 7 yards (21 feet) from the backstop. • When moving to and from the firing line your firearm must be unloaded, ECI installed, and the action open, magazine out or chamber(s) empty and muzzle straight up or the firearm may be 	<p>Adopted 2008</p>

unloaded and in it's case.

- Un-cased firearms in the club room must be unloaded, ECI installed and placed in the **Safe Handling Area**.
- No ammunition in the “safe handling area”.
- Dispose of defective live rounds in the marked red can. Do not throw live rounds or other debris in the backstop area or in the brass buckets.
- Alcoholic beverages and/or illegal drugs are PROHIBITED in the Club house.
- Guests must be with a member who shall be responsible for their conduct.
- Clean up after yourself including all down-range debris created by hits on your target and pick up all spent brass.
- With prior Board approval, Match or Event Director may modify these rules to conduct the specific match or event.
