**Description of Courses of Fire**  
**Spring - Fall - Winter**

**Tuesday Nights 900's shot at 75' Indoors**

The 900 Point Match consists of 4 different matches for a total of 90 shots. Each shot is worth up to 10 points.

**Match 1 Slow Fire Match** consists of 4 strings of 5 shots each, 10 shots in 10 minutes for a total of 20 minutes.

**Match 2 National Gallery Match - Outside.** This is called the National Match course and consists of 30 shots. Slow Fire - 2 strings of 5 shots each, 10 shots in 10 minutes. Timed Fire 2 strings of 5 shots each 5 shots in 20 seconds. Rapid Fire 2 strings of 5 shots each 5 shots in 10 seconds.

**Match 3 Timed Fire Match** consists of 4 strings of 5 shots each, 5 shots in 20 seconds.

**Match 4 Rapid Fire Match** consists of 4 strings of 5 shots each, 5 shots in 10 seconds.

**Spring - Fall - Winter**

**Thursday Night 300's Shot at 50'**

**Slow Fire**, 2 strings of 5 shots each, 10 shots in 10 minutes. **Timed Fire**, two strings of 5 shots each, 5 shots in 20 seconds. **Rapid Fire**, two strings of 5 shots each, 5 shots in 10 seconds. Each shot has a value of 10 points each for a possible score of 300. If you're shooting less than a perfect score Thursday night is for you. Example: If you're a 280 shooter and before shooting pick out a figure of 20 and if you shoot 280 you will end up with a score of 300. We give prizes for the number of 300's you shoot as well as your placement. We also give prizes for scratch score. (Nothing added to your score)

**Outdoor Shooting April thru September**

Our outdoor range is at the National Guard Facility (DANG) on Rt. 9. It's the last gate on their reservation going towards Delaware City on the left. It's the gate before Ommelanden. Dan gets there at 4:30 and opens the gate for shooters and then closes it at 5:00 pm. Any shooter coming later that does not have a club key can call Dan at 559-6106 for entry. We shoot 3 relays of 30 shots each. Slow Fire is shot at 50 yards and timed and rapid are shot at 25 yards with turning targets. The National Guard and our Club built 20 covered firing points in 1995. We have a Ransom Rest for both outdoor and indoor shooting to test your ammunition and accuracy of your equipment. If you need a Ransom Rest for outdoor shooting please let us know in advance as the Rest is not kept outdoors.
